



Snow Information

Boone County Public Services reminds you during snow emergencies where snowfall is two inches or greater, it is required that vehicles parked on the street be moved from the street to allow trucks to safely and effectively treat and/or plow the streets.

Snow Emergencies

From Boone County's Snow Emergency Policy:

A Snow Emergency may be declared by the Boone County Judge-Executive directly or through the Boone County Emergency Management Office after consultation between the Boone County Emergency Management Office, the Boone County Public Works Department and the Boone County Sheriff Department.

Snow Emergencies shall be defined at one of the following levels:

Level One: Motorists are advised to use caution due to hazardous road conditions resulting from accumulations of snow and/or ice.

Level Two: Road conditions are extremely hazardous due to snow and/or ice and essential travel only is advised.

Level Three: Road conditions are extremely dangerous and travel is restricted to the following purposes: Public safety and emergency personnel travel; Travel to and from work if required by your employer; Travel for medical purposes or to obtain necessary provisions. Travel for any other purposes is considered to be nonessential and violations will be enforced by law enforcement personnel.

This week at the Fiscal Court

At the Fiscal Court meeting this week, a resolution was passed that awarded the bid for the 60 acre agricultural lease of Valley Orchards to Richard Crisler and Terry Anderson. Of the two bids received, theirs was the higher at \$101.50 per acre. This two year agreement will generate \$12,180 in revenue. This property is located along the Ohio River along River Road.

Also, a bid for a 15' Batwing Aerator was awarded to Midwestern Golf & Turf. The funding for this piece of equipment was from the field usage fee applied to the recreational sporting leagues. This fee was earmarked in the county's budget to improve the quality of the fields. A sample photograph of a batwing aerator is included below.



Two sidewalk projects in Hebron will now move forward after the bid approval at the meeting. The Conner Safe Routes to Schools sidewalk project was awarded to Straight Edge Construction. This sidewalk will provide pedestrian access from near the Conner Campus along Limaburg Road to Kentucky 20 in Hebron and from Merrie Drive along Conner Road to Goodridge Elementary. The other sidewalk project was awarded to RA Miller Construction Company. This sidewalk will stretch along the South side of KY 20 from Limaburg Road to Merrie Drive next to Mr. Herbs restaurant.

These are other items that were considered and approved at the meeting: County Clerk's Budget, lease for erection of a cell tower at Lassing Pointe Golf Course, creation of two viewing committees in Burlington and Belleview.
