Consumer Electronics Aftermarket Service and Supply Chain Leader to lease 73,500 square feet in Boone County facility and hire 25 employees

(Boone County, KY) February 17, 2009 – Andrews Electronics, a division of MTI-Andrews headquartered in Hillsboro, Oregon, is pleased to announce that it will establish operations in a Boone County facility. Andrews Electronics is one of North America’s largest consumer electronic parts distribution and reverse logistics companies, providing a variety of essential services to manage the lifecycle of their customers supply chains. “Andrews Electronics will be a fantastic asset to Kentucky’s business base,” said Gov. The company’s consumer electronics parts and accessories processing center will be located in 73,500 square feet of space in the Skyport V Building located on 2265 Progress Drive in Hebron, KY. Andrews Electronics will initially hire 25 employees.
