COUNTY LOOKING FOR WAYS TO SAVE ON ENERGY

BOONE COUNTY, KY — The Boone County Fiscal Court has selected Energy Systems Group to conduct a series of energy audits for all of its fiscal court buildings including the County golf courses. The Court approved the contract at its Tuesday, January 6th meeting.

Kentucky based Energy Systems Group will conduct the free audit, which will take about 90 days to complete. The audit will review the County's energy expenses over the past year on water, sewer, gas, and electric on all fiscal court facilities including the golf courses. Once the County has had an opportunity to review the audits findings it will then determine if a formal request for proposals is necessary. At that point Energy Systems Group will then be able to submit a proposal along with any other interested service provider.

The energy audit is aimed at helping identify practical and financially viable improvements or modifications that could produce annual energy savings for the County. Most often the savings comes as a result of energy efficiency measures which in turn lead to a reduction in energy consumption.

Judge/Executive Gary W. Moore said, "Hopefully, we can identify strategies to make our buildings more energy efficient while at the same time saving tax dollars." Judge Moore added, "This audit has the real potential to help the County achieve both short- and long-term savings on our energy bills."
