Fall Cleanup – FREE Junk Disposal!

It's the time of year for some Fall-cleaning and Boone County wants to help out!

Fall Clean-Up Drop Off Program: From October 20 through the 26, between the hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Boone County is sponsoring a Fall Clean-Up Drop Off Program. You may bring your bulk items, tree and brush debris and other junk to our Public Works Yard at the end of Maplewood Drive in Burlington (past the Fairgrounds) or to the Union Pool on Old Union Road and we will dispose of it – Free of charge!

Large item such as refrigerators, air conditioning units, household furniture, garbage, brush, or just general junk is also acceptable. The Public Services Department will also accept refrigerators, air conditioning units, or other items containing Freon (CFC'S) throughout the year during regular business hours. The Solid Waste Department works in cooperation with the Boone County Public Works Department who removes the Freon at no charge. All such items are then recycled.

We will accept only four tires per vehicle. We will NOT accept paint, batteries, liquid waste or hazardous waste nor will we accept items from commercial entities. If a resident has items that might be questionable, please call before the items are brought to our facility!
