COUNTY LOOKS FOR FEEDBACK ON GREENWAYS PLAN

The Boone County Planning Commission will host open meetings to discuss Greenways

BOONE COUNTY, KY — The Boone County Planning Commission has a new initiative to develop a Greenways Master Plan throughout the County. This is a long-term plan for identifying and managing the county's greenways. According to Kevin Costello, Executive Director of the Planning Commission, "The goal of this plan is to create a vision and framework for a system that connects people with great public spaces such as parks, schools, neighborhoods, and commercial areas."

The Boone County Planning Commission will be holding two initial public workshops regarding the Boone County Greenways Plan. The first workshop will be held on March 31, 2008 from 4:00-7:00 p.m. in Rooms B and C at the Boone County Public Library located at 1786 Burlington Pike in Burlington. The second public workshop will be held on April 7, 2008 from 4:00-7:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of Walton-Verona High School located at 30 School Road in Walton.

"This is an excellent opportunity for Boone County to create a legacy of great public spaces connected to communities through a robust greenspace system," said Judge/Executive Gary W. Moore "The Greenways Master Plan is a plan that belongs to the people of this county, the community's support and feedback on this plan is an essential ingredient to making this plan a successful reality."

Information about greenways and the master plan schedule will be available at both workshops. Suggestions and comments about greenways are needed as the Planning Commission begins with this project. The public is encouraged to attend.
