**Boone County Fiscal Court votes to hire McConnell aide  
\*\*Judge/Executive recommends saving \$74,000 annually\*\***

Boone County Fiscal Court voted at its June 23, 2009 meeting to hire Senator Mitch McConnell's Northern Kentucky field representative Adam Howard as the county's Government and Community Relations Director.

Judge/Executive Gary Moore said, "By reducing the number of staff in the Judge/Executive's office from five to four, this will save the county \$74,000 annually including benefits." The position was created by combining two positions into one.

Both Senator McConnell and Congressman Geoff Davis offered their praise. "Adam has lived his entire life in Northern Kentucky so he understands the issues important to the region," said Senator McConnell. "He has been a terrific member of my team and I wish him the best on this new endeavor." Congressman Davis added, "I enjoyed working with Adam Howard during his time in Senator McConnell's office. I found him to be a reliable and trustworthy partner on issues affecting this region. I look forward to continuing our productive relationship as he transitions to Judge/Executive Gary Moore's office."

In this role, Adam's responsibilities will include serving as a liaison with legislators and business groups along with addressing constituent concerns with county government. He will begin work on July 6<sup>th</sup>.
