Kentucky Transportation Cabinet District 6 Boone County Maintenance Schedule

COVINGTON, Ky. (March 13, 2009) - The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet District 6 Superintendent Jason Braun announced the following maintenance activities in Boone County for the week March 16 – March 20th:

Monday, March 16 - Wednesday, March 18

- Crews will continue ditching with equipment on KY 1925 (Big Bone Road) from KY 338 to Rice Pike (mp 3 – 5). Watch for flaggers and equipment.
- A crew will be repairing and replacing road signs district wide on state routes. Watch for crews and equipment.

Thursday, March 19 - Friday, March 20

- Crews will continue patching and repairing potholes on various state routes throughout Boone County. Watch for flaggers and equipment.
- A crew will be repairing and replacing road signs district wide on state routes. Watch for crews and equipment.

If you have a pothole to report on a **state route**, you can call Boone County Maintenance at 859-371-5421 or you can call a toll free direct line to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to report potholes or other problems on all state maintained highways. The number is 1-800-PATCH IT or 1-800-728-2448.

Maintenance activities are scheduled on a tentative basis and are subject to change depending on weather conditions, emergencies and other factors beyond the control of the Department of Highways.

Motorists are urged to use caution in work areas, and to be alert for flaggers workers equipment which may block a portion of the roadway, and other items of concern in work zone speed limits where applicable.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet District 6 maintains nearly 679 lane miles of highways in Boone County.
