PARK SHELTER RESERVATIONS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE BOONE COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT

BOONE COUNTY, KY — Reservations for picnic shelters may be made by calling 859-334-2117, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Payment must be made by cash or check within seven (7) days of making the reservation. Shelter reservation fees are \$25.00.

If payment is not received within 14 days of the date the reservation was made, the reservation will be canceled.

A \$5.00 handling charge is assessed for change of date and/or shelter reserved, after confirmation letter is sent. The original confirmation letter, along with the \$5.00 payment must be returned to parks office prior to receiving new confirmation of change.

Special Events Requiring a Shelter Reservation

Anyone making a shelter reservation who wishes to conduct a pig roast, dunking booth, or any other such extra activity not sponsored by Boone County Parks, must make a request in writing to the Park Director.

No-charge Shelter Reservations

The following agencies and organizations will be not charged for shelter use; however, if any special events as outlined above are included, permission must be requested.

All Boone County, Cities of Florence, Walton, and Union offices; Boone County Schools (public and parochial) for student/faculty outings, clubs, field trips, etc.; Boone County Emergency Services including Fire, Police, EMA; and Boone County Boy Scout and Girl Scout Troops for troop related activities.

Any no-charge reservation other than those listed above must have the approval of the Park Director or his designee.
