Spring Cleanup – FREE Junk Disposal!

It's the time of year for some spring-cleaning and Boone County, the City of Florence, and the City of Walton want to help out!

Appliance Recycling: You may bring your appliances and salvage metal to our Public Works Yard, located off Maplewood Drive (which is off Idlewild Road in Burlington) and we will take care of the rest – free of charge. Appliances accepted include refrigerators, washers, dryers, water heaters, ranges, dishwashers and room air conditioners.

Spring Clean-Up Drop Off Program: April 27—May 3, Boone County is sponsoring a Spring Clean-Up Drop Off Program. You may bring your bulk items and other junk to our **Public Works Yard in Burlington and Union Pool off Old Union Rd.** and we will dispose of it – Free of charge! We will take these items only on the days specified and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. We will accept only four tires per vehicle. We will NOT accept paint, batteries, liquid waste or hazardous waste nor will we accept items from commercial entities. If a resident has items that might be questionable, please call before the items are brought to our facilities!
