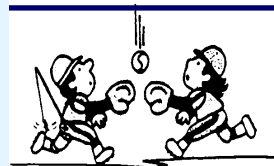

# Park Shelter Reservations for 2012 begin on March 1!

We know it's early, but mark your calendars now because these shelters go fast!!! We reserve shelters from April thru October and the cost is \$35 for the entire day. We recommend that you visit the shelter you are planning to reserve before you make your reservations to be sure that it will suit your needs. Remember, these shelters are outdoors and there are times when there will be insects flying around (bees, mosquitoes, ants, etc). To reserve a shelter please call Boone County Parks @ 859-334-2117 between 8 am – 5 pm. You cannot reserve a shelter on line or through e-mail.

Please be advised that we do not accept reservations for weddings. The only park facility suitable for weddings is at the Florence Nature Center, managed by the City of Florence, call 859-647-5416.

**Shelter reservations must be paid within 10 days of making the reservation. There will be a due date on the letter sent with your invoice. If not paid by the due date, your reservation will be cancelled. We will not contact you before cancelling.**

Shelters and amenities are available at the following parks:

**Boone Woods Park** 6000 Veterans Way, Burlington, KY 41005. 3 shelters. They have electricity & nearby water. The restrooms & playgrounds are within walking distance. Each shelter can hold approx. 80 comfortably.



**England-Idlewild Park** 5550 Idlewild Road, Burlington, KY 41005. 3 shelters. They have electricity & nearby water. The port-o-lets & playground are within walking distance. Each shelter can hold approx. 80 comfortably.

**Walton Community Park** 35 Old Stephenson Mill Road, Walton, KY 41094. 3 shelters. They have electricity & nearby water. The restrooms & playground are nearby. Each shelter can hold approx. 80 comfortably.

**Central Park** 9190 Camp Ernst Road, Union, KY 41091. 2 shelters. They have electricity & nearby water. Restrooms & playground are close to Shelter 1. Shelter 2 has nearby port-o-lets. Each shelter can hold approx. 80 comfortably.



**Lincoln Woods Park** 1 City Park Drive, Florence, KY 41042. 1 shelter. It has electricity, nearby water, restrooms & a playground. The shelter can hold approx. 70 comfortably.

**Giles Conrad Park** 7500 River Road, Hebron, KY 41048. 1 shelter. It has electricity, nearby port-o-lets & a playground. The shelter can hold approx. 70 comfortably.
