### **South Airfield Road Groundbreaking**

Burlington, KY — The Boone County Fiscal Court is pleased to announce the official groundbreaking for the South Airfield Road Project will occur on Wednesday, May 18, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. along KY-18 East of Oakbrook Drive. This Boone County Fiscal Court project is funded in part through an appropriation secured by Congressman Geoff Davis. Project development and design have been funded through local sources. The cost of construction, estimated at \$13 million, will be funded primarily through federal dollars. Total project investment is estimated at \$18 million.

Judge Moore said, "This groundbreaking is a culmination of years of hard work from our administration. Through the efforts of Congressman Davis and the other funding partners, including the Fiscal Court, residents in Boone County will have shorter commute times and less congestion."

This road will travel from Oakbrook Drive along the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport's southern border to Turfway Road in Florence. Approximately 800 acres will be opened up for development. The road is projected to carry 49,000 cars per day by 2030.
