SUMMER!!

What are your plans?

Our camps help working families make permanent, safe, affordable summer arrangements for their children. Each day is broken into age

appropriate activities and opportunities for your child to learn and grow in a fun, positive environment. We like to have all of our campers at camp by 9 AM and to stay until 4 PM. Our Staff is on site until 6 PM in case there are traffic problems.

SWIMMING LOCATIONS

Our indoor/outdoor camps are held at each of the schools listed on the front of the brochure. Parents can choose the location that is closest to them. Within the schools, we use the gym, cafeteria, and the nearest restrooms. We also have access to the outside play equipment, trails, ball fields, etc. We pay attention to the weather forecasts when planning our daily activities.

FIELD TRIPS

We have so many awesome opportunities around us and it's important for our campers to enjoy their summer so we include field trips or guests each week of the summer. Cost is included in the weekly fee and transportation is through the BC Schools on the yellow school buses or through a charter company with the same style buses.



STAFF



We are very lucky to have an awesome staff. The staff at each camp consists of two On Site Coordinators and six counselors. These positions are filled by adults, college and high school students who are hired and approved by the Boone County Fiscal Court in early spring. Our ratio at the school is less than 10 to 1. We do bring in our other seasonal Parks staff to help on big field trips. The lower the ratio, the better! Staff is trained in CPR and First Aid and have background checks.



We swim each week, weather permitting. During the first week of camp, we will be testing our campers swimming ability at the Union Pool by the life guards. We then split our campers up by swimming ability-not age when we go swim. Transportation is by bus. We will then use the Union Pool and the Florence Aquatic Center for swimming. Swimming days are determined by camp location.
