ITEM II. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A. Judge Moore presented the Minutes from the July 24, 2018 Fiscal Court Meeting for approval. Commissioner Walton moved, seconded by Commissioner Kenner, to approve the Minutes from the July 24, 2018 Fiscal Court Meeting, with no changes. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, MOTION PASSED AYE 3-0 with one abstention by Commissioner Flaig due to her absence on July 24, 2018.

ITEM III. **PRESENTATIONS**

Judge Moore introduced Assistant Chief Joey Vest from the Walton Fire District. Mr. Vest stated the tax was passed by the local Fire Department Board at \$1.99 per \$1,000 for residential property. All other tax rates were \$2.00 per \$1,000. Assistant Chief shared the future goals of the Walton Fire District. Commissioner Flaig asked about number of Firefighters, Assistant Chief Vest responded. Judge Moore thanked him for his service.

ITEM IV. **PERSONNEL MATTERS**

A. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. A: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE OF BRANDON GRIFFIN TO THE POSITION OF PROPERTY MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN FOR THE PROPERTY MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT LOCATED AT THE JAIL FACILITY. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, stated this is the new position approved by the Court. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

B. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. B: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF KELLEY CARL TO THE FULL-TIME POSITION OF RECORDS CLERK FOR THE PSCC DEPARTMENT. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, stated this is a vacant position and this candidate has vast experience. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

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C. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. C: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF AUSTIN KRESSER TO THE FULL-TIME POSITION OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOR THE BOONE COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, stated this position is open due to a resignation. This candidate has worked part time and has a lot of experience. Commissioner Walton moved, seconded by Commissioner Flaig, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

D. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. D: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF JASON CALLIHAN AND STEVEN DAY TO THE FULL-TIME POSITION OF PUBLIC SERVICES LABORER FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, stated this will fill a vacant position and this candidate has construction experience. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

E. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. E: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF RICHARD DIXON AS A SEASONAL NEW HIRE AND A PAY INCREASE FOR STEVE HUFF AS SEASONAL MAINTENANCE STAFF FOR THE BOONE COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, explained these are seasonal positions for the Parks Department. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

F. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. F: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF STACEY BUUS AND HEATHER SMITH AS CO-DIRECTORS FOR THE 21ST CENTURY GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE BOONE COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, commented these are seasonal workers that are paid through the Grant. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

G. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item IV. G: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF TIMOTHY JONES AS FULL-TIME PARK LABORER/TRUCK DRIVER FOR THE BOONE COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT. Lori Zombek, Director of Human Resources, commented this position is for weekends for Parks. Commissioner Walton moved, seconded by Commissioner Kenner, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 3-0, with one recusal by Commissioner Flaig.

ITEM V.

ORDINANCES

A. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record the First Reading of Item V. A: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT ENACTING AND ADOPTING SUPPLEMENT 2018 S-21 TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE COUNTY OF BOONE, KENTUCKY. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, explained this is a housekeeping item to have all Ordinances adopted through the 2018 fiscal year into our Code Book. Judge Moore stated the second reading will be September 11th.

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B. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record the First Reading of Item V. B: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF GOLF CARTS ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED COUNTY STREETS AND ROADWAYS. Judge Moore stated this is an item that the Court needs to move forward. Matthew Webster, Assistant County Administrator explained the requirements for golf carts are listed by state statute. All are safety requirements. Judge Moore stated roads will be designated by the Court from existing communities that have requested the use of golf carts. Commissioner Flaig asked a question, Matthew Webster responded. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator stated the roads are in unincorporated Boone County which are the Court's jurisdiction. Judge Moore stated Cities are not included in this Ordinance. The statute is KRS 189.286. The second reading will be September 11th, 2018.

C. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record the First Reading of Item V. C: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF SIDEWALKS AND MULTI-USE PATHS IN BOONE COUNTY, KENTUCKY. Matthew Webster, Assistant County Administrator, explained this addressed motor vehicle usage on sidewalks and multi-use paths to be consistent with the golf cart Ordinance. Judge Moore stated the second reading will be September 11, 2018.

D. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record the Second Reading of Item V. D: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT APPROVING, WITH CONDITIONS, A REQUEST OF MARC GLOYESKE (APPLICANT) FOR KREUTZJANS YEAGER PROPERTIES, LLC (OWNER) FOR A ZONING MAP AMENDMENT FROM COMMERCIAL TWO (C-2) TO INDUSTRIAL ONE (I-1), AND A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A 2.69 ACRE SITE LOCATED ON THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE PETERSBURG ROAD/LINDBERG COURT INTERSECTION, BOONE COUNTY, KENTUCKY. THE REQUEST IS FOR A ZONE CHANGE AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW A HOTEL. Judge Moore stated on the first reading of this Ordinance there was some discussion about pedestrian connections or sidewalks being created. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, stated this development plan did contain four (4) conditions of approval and we would like to add number 5 to construct a public sidewalk for this four-story hotel. Judge Moore asked if there were any questions or comments to include the additional condition. Commissioner Kenner moved to approve the Ordinance with the additional fifth condition of completing sidewalks to the project, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Ordinance with the fifth condition. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

E. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record the Second Reading of Item V. E: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 2018 IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,100,000 (WHICH AMOUNT MAY BE DECREASED AS NECESSARY); APPROVING THE FORM OF BONDS; AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED OFFICERS TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT AND SECURITY OF THE BONDS; CREATING A BOND PAYMENT FUND; MAINTAINING THE HERETOFORE ESTABLISHED SINKING FUND; AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE BID OF THE BOND PURCHASER FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE BONDS; AND REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES. Judge Moore stated the Court will not take any action on this Ordinance, there is more work to be done. We will defer the Second Reading until the Fiscal Court Meeting scheduled for August 28th at 5:30.

ITEM VI.

JUDGE'S REPORT

A. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. A: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF PAMELA GOETTING TO THE NORTHERN KENTUCKY AREA DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS. Judge Moore explained this appointment will replace Louis Kelly, who is running for Commonwealth Attorney. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

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B. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VI. B: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF JEFFREY CASAZZA AND TERESA HAMRICK TO THE PARKING VIOLATION AND 911 DWELLING UNIT SERVICE FEE HEARING BOARD. Judge Moore commented this Board now has dual purpose, Parking Hearing and the 911 dwelling unit service fee hearing Board. These are new appointments which applied through our on-line applications. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Flaig, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

C. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VI. C: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF DAVID TURNER TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF DICK WILKINSON ON THE BOONE COUNTY URBAN FORESTRY COMMISSION. Judge Moore stated this is a new appointment, the candidate came to us from the ENGAGE program. He is employed at P&G and is on the Walton School Board. Commissioner Walton moved, seconded by Commissioner Flaig, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

D. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VI. D: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE RE-APPOINTMENT, BY GARY W. MOORE, COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE, OF PATRICK RAVERTY TO THE NORTHERN KENTUCKY AREA DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS. Judge Moore stated that Mr. Raverty's terms has ended and he wishes to serve again. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Kenner, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

ITEM VII.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

A. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. A: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE 2019 FISCAL YEAR. Judge Moore stated during the Budget session it was discussed that there is a need to connect areas and some are safety improvements and money was made available. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, showed slides of locations where sidewalks will be constructed; Cayton Road, Beemon Lane, Conrad Lane, Dublin Drive, Frogtown Road, Idlewild Park and Shoreland Drive. The improvements total about \$1.37M. We will work with Engineers to design. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

B. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. B: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT DECLARING A TRAILBLAZER UTILITY TRAILER, COUNTY UNIT #298, USED BY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AS SURPLUS AND DONATING IT TO OWEN COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, stated this is a small utility trailer that is being taken out of service and Owen County E.M Department has requested transfer of the vehicle, without payment. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

C. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. C: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT APPROVING THE PROPOSED PROJECT/EQUIPMENT PURCHASES UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE "BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM FY2018" FOR TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT TO BE USED IN THE ELECTRONIC CRIME DIVISION FOR THE BOONE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, explained this grant is for \$10,000 to replace electric

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Tasers. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Flaig, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

D. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. D: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AWARDING THE BID FOR PROGRAM MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO ASSIST THE COUNTY IN PLANNING, MONITORING AND MANAGING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FOR THE BRIGHTON RECOVERY KENTUCKY CENTER TO ATKINS-ELROD & ASSOCIATES. Matthew Webster, Assistant County Administrator, stated this is an annual appointment to manage the Grant. We received 1 response to the RFP. There is no liability to the Court. Commissioner Flaig asked a question, Judge Moore responded. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

E. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. E: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AWARDING THE BID FOR CALL HANDLING (NG911) TO INDIGITAL DUE TO THE TERMINATION OF THE EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE SERVICE AGREEMENT FROM CINCINNATI BELL. Jim Staverman, Director of PSCC, stated Cincinnati Bell is out of the 911 software business. A bid was put out in April, we received 4 proposals. This Agreement involves five counties. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Kenner, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

F. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. F: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT APPROVING THE SELECTION OF GEOSTABILIZATION INTERNATIONAL LLC., TO PERFORM SOIL WALL REPAIRS AT SLIDE AREAS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN BOONE COUNTY AT THE COST OF \$201,029.04 THROUGH THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY MASTER AGREEMENT. Scott Pennington, County Engineer, stated this is to secure slides. Zig Zag Road and Stephenson Mill Road need repair. These prices are through the State Master Agreement. Judge Moore commented that a line item was added to the Budget this year specifically for slide repair. Commissioner Walton moved, seconded by Commissioner Kenner, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

G. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. G: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF PUBLICATION REQUIREMENT CHANGES AUTHORIZED BY THE ENACTMENT OF HOUSE BILL 487 IN THE 2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION. Matthew Webster, Assistant County Administrator, explained the publication requirements, the County will have notices in the paper quarterly, in the future, all postings will be on the website and will be a savings to the County. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

H. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. H: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE SELECTION OF SCOTT TRANTER AS THE PREFERRED CONSULTANT FOR UTILITY EASEMENT APPRAISALS FOR THE EVERGREEN/RIDGEVIEW SANITARY SEWER PROJECT. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, stated the Grant requires professional service for appraisals. There are 90 to 100 easements in yards for the new sewer lines. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Flaig, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 3-0, Commissioner Walton recused himself from voting.

I. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. I: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AWARDING THE BID FOR A 108HP RUBBER-TIRE BACKHOE TO SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC., AT A BID PRICE OF \$117,500.00 FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. Scott Pennington, County Engineer, stated this purchase is in the Budget. Only 1 bid was received and this backhoe will replace an existing backhoe. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

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J. Judge Moore asked the Fiscal Court Clerk to read into the record Item VII. J: A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AWARDING THE BID FOR AN ASPHALT PAVER/SHOULDER MACHINE TO SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC., AT THE BID PRICE OF \$74,900.00 FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. Scott Pennington, County Engineer, stated this is a new item for our Department, in the past we had to borrow from other agencies. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton, to approve the Resolution. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

ITEM VIII.

FISCAL MATTERS

A. Judge Moore presented the Invoice Report dated August 14th, 2018 and a pre-paid Invoice Reports dated July 26th, August 2nd and August 9th, 2018. Commissioner Walton moved, seconded by Commissioner Kenner to approve the Invoice Reports. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0.

B. Judge Moore presented the Golf Invoice Report dated August 14th, 2018 and pre-paid Golf Invoice Reports dated July 26th, August 2nd and August 9th, 2018. Commissioner Flaig moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton to approve the Golf Invoice Reports. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0

C. Judge Moore presented the Monthly Treasurer's and Interfund Transfer Reports and Financial Statement for period ending June 30, 2018. Commissioner Kenner moved, seconded by Commissioner Walton to approve the Treasurer's and Interfund Transfer Reports and Financial Statement. Judge Moore called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE 4-0

ITEM IX.

OLD BUSINESS

Judge Moore stated there have been some inquiry to the closing of the Union Pool. Jeff Earlywine, County Administrator, explained this decision was not made lightly. A professional firm was called in to evaluate the pool. The pool operates at a deficit, attendance has declined. An estimate of \$3M was given to upgrade and repair the pool and surrounding decking. Judge Moore added there are 50 acres with the property, we do not plan on selling the property. The City of Union is a potential partner for a park.

Judge Moore asked Scott Pennington to give an update on the Veteran's Way project. Mr. Pennington stated work is being done near the YMCA and IHM. Due to wet weather we are behind schedule, the section next to 237 will open first.

Judge Moore asked if there was any New Business to come before the Court, none presented.
